## Exhibit Rules

Please take your physical exhibit entry fees and forms in a sealed envelope to the Highweek Village Hall by Wednesday 8th July. A committee member will be at the Hall from 6-8pm on the 8th July, but you can post your forms through the letterbox anytime before then. Online forms must also be submitted and paid by 8pm on Wednesday 8th July. **Forms will not be accepted on Show Day.**

1. All exhibits in the adult classes must have been either raised, grown or made by a competitor.
2. Any purchased pot plants must have been obtained at least 3 months prior to the show.
3. Children's classes are open to all children. Entries must be their own unaided efforts during the last 12 months.
4. The Exhibits Hall will be open to accept exhibit entries on Saturday 11th July between 8.30am and 10am at the Highweek Scout Hut, Howton Road. **No late entries will be accepted.**
5. No competitor shall win more than one award in any class.
6. Points awarded will be 1st 3 points, 2nd 2 points, 3rd 1 point.
7. Entries submitted will be auctioned at the end of the show.
8. Those items not for auction should be marked 'NOT FOR SALE'.
9. Please do not remove entries from the display before 4pm.
10. **All competitors must leave the Scout Hut at 10am. before the start of judging.**

All vehicles must be off the Scout Hut site by 10am. Spaces are very limited.

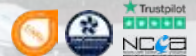

225g (8oz) Mixed fruit

2 eggs

100ml milk

Grated orange and lemon rind

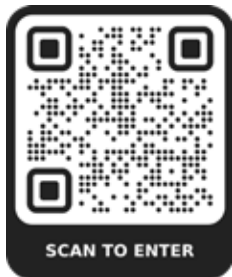
